Physicians

AAFP: The AAFP has reviewed the **20th International Clinical & Scientific Conference for Restorative Reproductive Medicine** and deemed it acceptable for up to 39.0 Live AAFP Prescribed credits. Term of Approval is from 08/07/2024 to 08/10/2024.



Recording Package (Self-Paced): AAFP has reviewed all sessions and lectures of the **20th International Clinical & Scientific Conference for Restorative Reproductive Medicine** and deemed it acceptable for 39.0 Enduring Materials, Self-Study AAFP Prescribed credit. Term of Approval is from 08/10/2024 to 08/10/2025.

AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™: AAFP Prescribed credit is accepted by the American Medical Association as equivalent to **AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™** toward the AMA Physician's Recognition Award. When applying for the AMA PRA, up to 39.00 Prescribed credit may be reported.

AOA: CME activities approved for AAFP credit are recognized by the AOA as equivalent to AOA Category 2 credit.

- Live attendance is reported as Category 2-A
- Self-paced (enduring) credit is reported as Category 2-B

CFPC: Members of the College of Family Physicians of Canada can receive 39.00 MAINPRO-M1 credits for participation in this activity due to a reciprocal agreement with the American Academy of Family Physicians.



Mutual recognition between the European Union (UEMS-EACCME®) and the American Medical Association (AMA)

The UEMS-EACCME and the AMA signed an agreement of mutual recognition of CME credits between Europe and the USA whereby European physicians can earn ECMECs by completing self-paced or in person learning from accredited providers from the United States that have been certified for *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*. 1 ECMEC is equivalent to 1 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit™*.

The UEMS-EACCME has agreements with the following countries therefore physicians from these countries may apply CME credits earned from the congress or pre-conferences to their country requirements:

Nurses, Midwives, Physician Assistants and Nurse Practitioners

AANPCB: The American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Certification Board accepts AAFP Prescribed credit.
